ITEMS TO BRING TO REGISTER A CHILD FOR BEL AIR MIDDLE SCHOOL

1. **Original Birth Certificate**
2. **Social Security Card**
3. **Immunization Record** – Must have had a second MMR vaccine. Also, students must have one dose of the Varicella vaccine for students under the age of 13 or two doses for ages 13 and older unless they have had the chicken pox. We will need documentation from a physician (month and year) that student had the chicken pox. For students going into 7th grade they will need a Tdap and meningitis vaccine.
4. **Report Cards/Grades**
5. **Standardized Test Scores** (CTBS, STANFORD, IOWA, ETC)
6. **PROOF OF RESIDENCE** (Preferred Choice).

A current monthly utility bill* (turn off notices not accepted) internet, cable, landline, gas & electric (usage detail page required).

7. **Legal Custody Papers** (if the child does not live with both biological parents, we must have official court documents signed by a judge and court stamped showing custody)
8. **Special Education records**
9. If the child wishes to be in **Band/Orchestra/Chorus**, please make sure parents check off on pink form in registration packet.
10. If a student is coming from out of state, you will need a **Health Inventory** form to be filled out by a physician and turned back in to our school nurse before school starts or six months after entering school.
11. If parent and student are residing with someone else other than their own home, the parent and owner/leaseholder will need to fill out a **Multi-Family Residency Affidavit** form. It must be filled out, notarized and returned with proof of residence to the PPW office for approval before student can start school.
