

Student Mobile Device Agreement

Students will be responsible for their assigned mobile device by:

- Bring the equipment to class and use the software at the direction of the teacher.
- Never leaving it unattended or loaning it out.
- Keeping it in good condition and notifying the school if it needs repairs.
- Using it in ways that are appropriate, educational, and follow all Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) policies and agreements (Use of Equipment/Materials by Students Policy and Responsible Use Procedure)
- Maintaining the original configuration and settings of the equipment and software as provided by HCPS, which include the following rules:
 - Removal of the security profile from the device is prohibited.
 - Apps may not be added to or deleted from the device
 - O Pictures, audio, video, and Internet history stored on the equipment are the property of HCPS.
- Returning it in the same state as it was received.

The device is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of HCPS.

Software access is only provided to the student and should not be shared.

In case of theft or vandalism, the parent/guardian will file a police report and notify the school immediately.

The parent/guardian will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse.

I understand and agree to the stipulations set forth in the above document. Additionally, I hereby release HCPS from any and all claims and damages of any nature arising from my child's use, or inability to use, the system.
